




## FIXING CERAMIC TILES TO SUSPENDED TIMBER FLOORS



## NOTES:

- 1. Provide adequate underfloor ventilation.
- 2. Ensure floorboards are securely fixed.
- Pre-level existing floor, if necessary, with Arditex to give a flush fit for the subsequently applied boards.
- 4. Refer to BS 5385: Part 3 clause 14.4 regarding sealing backs and edges of boards. A rigid base is essential. Fix dry WBP plywood of sufficient thickness (usually 18mm), with screws or ring nails at centres of 300mm or less. Use additional fixings at the edge of boards.
- Once the board is securely fixed prime the surface being tiled with Ardion 82 primer and allow to dry.
- 6. Thin solid bed tiles on the dry primed surface using Ardurit S16 incorporating Ardion 90.
- Use Ardion 101 with Ardurit grout for water repellent, flexible joints.
